

## Pupil Premium

There are few children at this school who attract Pupil Premium Funding.

Pupil Premium payments are used to fund small group work and 1:1 focused, measurable interventions and support for children identified by the school's targeting and tracking procedures.

Residential trips, class visits and play therapy sessions have been funded for identified pupils.

The allocation for 2013 to 2014 was £16,501
