In **Literacy** we will be learning about:

- Drama and role-play

Y1:

- Common exception words
- Letter formation
- Spaces between words

Y2:

- Full stops and capital letters (including proper nouns)
- Question and exclamation marks
- Word classes (nouns, verbs and adjectives)

Mathematics

Y2 Addition and Subtraction – using concrete objects, pictures and mental recall; add and subtract two-digit numbers

Money – recognise and use £ and p symbols; combine amounts to make a specific value; find different combinations of coins that equal the same amount of money

Multiplication and Division – 2, 5 and 10 times tables; odd and even numbers; $x \div =$ symbols; arrays and repeated addition

Y1 Addition and subtraction – inverse operations; commutative addition; number bonds to 10

Place Value including composition of numbers – counting forwards and backwards to 100 and beyond; counting efficiently by grouping in 10s; represent numbers using Base 10, numerals and number names; reading and writing numerals and words; one more and one less; comparing and ordering numbers

All our maths will be linked to problem solving

Please help your child to recall their number bonds within and to 10.
