As per my earlier email, here is an explanation to our **Learning Projects**. Each weekly project has a whole school theme, for example, Week 1 is 'My Family'.

- Learning projects are grouped into Reception, Year 1/2, Year 3/4 and Year 5/6
- The projects have been created with an order in mind but you do not have to follow this.
- Later weeks are yet to be added for you to access but there is plenty to be getting on with!

What are the aims of the Learning Projects?

- To create learning opportunities for primary school children.
- To create a resource for parents that is easy to access and use - the focus is on parents being able to help deliver the content or children accessing it independently.
- Key learning is linked to the National Curriculum.
- To enable children to continue with their learning at home during an enforced shutdown.
- To enable families to focus on a joint topic and theme to promote family wide learning.
- To provide structure and focus to each day that an enforced shutdown occurs.
- To centralise online learning resources and links into an easy to manage format for families.

What happens if my child finds the learning too difficult?

Our first piece of advice to parents is that ALL children find elements of learning challenging at times so try not to worry if your child becomes stuck and you cannot explain it to them. If this happens then make a note of what they found hard and move onto another learning activity - the school will cover any misconceptions when we return.

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The Learning Projects which have been designed are based on the National Curriculum expectations for the year group which your child is in. It may be that your child finds the tasks set within the Learning Project for their year group too challenging, for example if they have additional learning needs. If this is the case, then we advise that your child accesses the Learning Projects which are set to the age range below, for example a child in Year 3/4 could attempt the KS1 Learning Project or Year 1 Learning Project, if this is more appropriate for them.

Wittersham CEP School would like to thank the Robin Hood MAT who have been generous in sharing their own learning projects for other schools to adapt.

I hope you enjoy this time with your children.

Above all else keep reading please. Share stories, read non-fiction, look things up on-line and read some more! Then play card games, dice games, dominoes and practise the basics like times tables

As I have said before – don't put too much pressure on yourselves. We fully expect to plan for filling lots of gaps when our children return to us. We will be ready for it!
